





## How do I get to Cambridge University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust?

## Where will my appointment be?

The Cambridge BioResource is located on the ground floor of 'S block', in the **NIHR Cambridge BRC Clinical Research Unit (also known as 'S2')**. S block is diagonally opposite the Food Court outdoor eating area. Parking is available in the patient and visitor car parks (Car Park 1 or Car Park 2) and there are some disabled parking spaces adjacent to the S block entrance. There is bicycle parking directly outside the entrance to the unit.

## How do I get from Car Park 1 to the Cambridge BioResource?

- Coming out of the lifts, turn right and go out of the exit towards the courtesy bus stop
- Carry on past the bus stop and cross the road at the zebra crossing
- Follow Richard Howe Way to your left and go past Barton House on your right. You will see S block now in front of you. Turn left to go along Keith Day road – S block is now on your right hand side
- When you reach the Haematology Day unit cross the road to S block and the entrance to the Centre

## How do I get from Car Park 2 to the Cambridge BioResource?

- Exit the car park and cross the road at the zebra crossing
- Turn left and continue along Robinson Way
- Turn right onto Keith Day road and continue past the Treatment Centre and Cambridge Clinical Research Centre
- At the end of the path turn left, passing the outside eating area to your right, S block is now on your left
- When you reach the Haematology Day unit cross the road to S block and the entrance to the Centre

## How do I get into the Cambridge BioResource?

There are two entrances in to the NIHR Cambridge BRC Clinical Research Unit:

1. Door to the left of the sliding door goes straight in to reception
2. Go in through the sliding doors and take the first door on the left

Please note that you will need to ring the bell to gain entry
